Qurbani (Udhiya) and its reward:

"It is neither their flesh nor their blood that reaches Allah; it is your piety that reaches Him."
(Surah Al-Hajj 22:37)

"There is nothing dearer to Allah during the days of Qurbani than the sacrificing of animals. The sacrificed animal shall come on the Day of Judgment with its horns, hair, and hooves (to be weighed). The sacrifice is accepted by Allah before the blood reaches the ground. Therefore sacrifice with an open and happy heart." (Tirmizi, Ibne Majah)

"Qurbani is the way of your fore father Ibrahim. There is a reward for every hair." (Ibne Majah)

Obligation:

Qurbani is obligatory on each Muslim (male or female) who hold a Nisab i.e minimal level of wealth. It is highly virtuous for one on whom Qurbani is not obligatory to offer sacrifice for the Pleasure of Allah. He will be eligible for all the reward mentioned in the Ahadeeth.

"Whoever has the capacity to sacrifice and does not do so, should not come to the place where the Eid prayer is offered." (Ibne Majah)

Qurbani on behalf of others:

If one has been favoured by Allah with wealth, then he should also perform Qurbani on behalf of Prophet (peace be upon him), his Sahabah, his Ummah, or his own living or deceased relatives. Prophet (sallallahu alayhi wasallam) sacrificed one ram and while sacrificing the other he said, "This is on behalf of every one of my Ummah who believed in me and testified (to my prophethood)." (Tabrani)

Hazrat Hanash reported: I saw Hazrat Ali sacrificing two rams. I asked him, "What is this?" He said: "Verily the Messenger of Allah (pbuh) left instruction to me to sacrifice on his behalf, and so I am sacrificing on his behalf. (Tirmizi, Abu Daud)
